Dr. Londoño is originally from Mexico City, and she received all her education in the Los Angeles Area, going to Claremont McKenna College for her undergraduate studies, then attending UCLA for her medical school training. She finished a 6-year residency in Urology at Kaiser Permanente, Los Angeles.

She has experienced burnout twice which led her to use her experiences and become a writer and speaker discussing topics such as wellness, boundaries, ego, humanity in medicine, mindset, and mindfulness. Her experiences led her to become a Certified Life Coach and Founder of Physician Coach Support.com, a free and confidential 1:1 peer support platform for physicians which is available, 7 days a week via zoom.

She incorporates movement in her talks and will dance or #moveforwellness to promote messages about self-care on IG.

She also has been featured on TV on Univision, Telemundo, Mundo Fox, CNN Latino, KCET, and as a health consultant and discussing different urological topics.




Hope Street Margolis Family Center, a program of Dignity Health – California Hospital Medical Center in partnership with UCLA



Mark Goulston, MD, FAPA Author, Just Listen



Mark Goulston, M.D., F.A.P.A. defines "emotional and mental health as your ability to modify your immediate internal reaction to whatever life throws at you so that your behavioral response is constructive instead of destructive." That is one example from the book he is currently working on entitled, *Hidden in Plain Sight*, which describes many of the situations in life in a way that they can be more effectively dealt with.

He is a former UCLA Assistant Clinical Professor of Psychiatry focusing on suicide prevention and FBI and police hostage negotiation trainer. He is a co-founder of "The Rising Tide Challenge," which analogous to the "Ice Bucket Challenge" is a multiplatform movement for the 99% of the world to have their voices heard by completing the phrase, "My hopeful future will have..." He is the co-creator and moderator of the documentary, *Stay Alive: An Intimate Conversation about Suicide Prevention* and an Executive Producer of the documentary, What I Wish My Parents Knew.

He is the inventor and developer of Surgical Empathy which is a process to unlock and free people from destructive thoughts, feelings and impulses from their inside out by helping them to "feel felt." He is the author or co-author of nine books that have been translated into 42 languages.

His book, *Just Listen*, became the top book on listening in the world and was recently selected as the #4 book from "The 15 Best Communication Skills Books of All Time" by MostRecommendedBooks.com. He is one of the world's leading healthy conflict coaches, a Marshall Goldsmith 100 Coach and was named by Leadershum as #60 in the Top 200 Biggest Voices in Leadership to watch for in 2022. He hosts the highly ranked podcast, *My Wakeup Call* and is co-founder of 90 Second Mentor on LinkedIn.



Ali Gholamrezanezhad, MD, FEBNM, DABR

> Director of Clinical Research, Dept of Radiology Keck School of Medicine of USC



Ali Gholamrezanezhad, Associate Professor of Clinical Radiology at the Keck School of Medicine of University of Southern California (USC). He is the director of clinical research for the department of radiology and associate section chief of emergency radiology.

His research projects have focused on emergency radiology. Having especially put a focus on research to explore new horizons in critical situations, he finds that this has been among the most valuable takeaways for his work. Reason being, it will complement his hands-on practice and teaching to allow him to have both an immediate and long-term impact on patient care, especially during emergency situations such as trauma and epidemic/pandemics like COVID-19.

He is currently leading a multinational research team investigating the clinical and nonclinical features of the COVID-19 outbreak. Being able to have a personal impact in response to the current global pandemic has been a thrilling feeling for him. To date, his team has produced more than 55 journal articles. Our areas of focus have included investigating the radiologic presentations of COVID-19, clinical factors predisposing patients to complications of COVID-19 (such as ICU admission, intubation, or death), long-term pulmonary consequences of COVID-19, the impact of the global pandemic on healthcare workers and medical students, radiology department preparedness for surge potential, factors influencing differential case-fatality rates in countries worldwide, and the best approach to transition to the post-COVID-19 era. Over the past several months, the COVID-19 publications of his team have been cited more than 6500 times and have accumulated more than 500,000 downloads by the scientific and medical community across the world.

Family & Sports Medicine (Posthumous Honoree)

Dr. Cheng was an uncomplicated, humble, and utmost-giving man.

He supported his community in so many ways. He donated multiple hours of his time on so many different occasions. Dr. Cheng always listened to his patients and gave them the time they needed to feel heard.

Dr. Cheng practiced medicine in ways we admired. He always assured his patients left our practice feeling so much better than when they arrived.

One amazing anecdote, we will always remember from Dr. Cheng is him leading a team meeting and him using the analogy of "you never know what someone else is dealing with, in their backyard". He was speaking to us, his team, about compassion and empathy. He stressed that although someone might come in cranky, we should consider our reaction since we do not know "what they have seeded." His primary goal was to provide excellent patient care.

Dr. Cheng was a natural protector and healer. It was characteristic of Dr. Cheng, to charge forward at the gunman. It doesn't surprise any of us, that he was the HERO! Dr. Cheng, exemplified, what he was built for. His heroism saved so many people, NOT only at that church but throughout his career. Dr. Cheng's courageous act to move as fast as he did to save lives is no shock. He will forever be remembered as OUR HERO.



STEVE KERR

Head coach for the Golden State Warriors and a strong advocate for gun violence prevention.

Heave of Cannade

Steve Kerr was born on September 27, 1965, in Beirut, Lebanon. He attended Palisades Charter High School in Los Angeles and went on to the University of Arizona. He played 15 seasons in the NBA with various teams. Most notably, in 1993, Kerr signed with the Chicago Bulls and helped the organization win three consecutive NBA Finals. He was named Head Coach in Warriors history on May 19, 2014.

In an NBA press conference on May 24, 2022, Kerr diverged from talking about his team's opportunity to clinch a berth in the NBA Finals and instead emotionally addressed the unspeakable events at Robb Elementary School that had recently left 19 children and two adults dead.

Kerr chose to touch upon a subject that was bigger than basketball, having been impacted by gun violence himself when his father was shot by a gunman when Kerr was only 18 years old. Video of the event went viral, garnering tens of millions of views and broad media coverage.

"When are we going to do something?" Kerr added as he pounded on the table in front of him. "I'm tired, I'm so tired of getting up here and offering condolences to the devastated families that are out there."

Coach Kerr Kerr regularly gives his time and name to gun violence prevention groups including Brady, March for Our Lives, and Giffords.

Coach Kerr and his wife, Margot, have three children (Nick, Maddy, & Matthew).

PFIZER

One of the premier biopharmaceutical companies to develop the COVID-19 vaccine.



On March 11, 2020, the World Health Organization declared COVID-19 a pandemic1. Just six days later, on March 17, Pfizer signed a letter of intent with BioNTech to co-develop a potential COVID-19 vaccine.

BioNTech, a German immunotherapy company, had pioneered a new genetic technology that uses a wisp of genetic code from a virus—called messenger RNA—to prompt cells to make antibodies that fight off that virus. For decades, scientists had been working on similar concepts but frequently met defeat because of issues related to the structure and stability of the mRNA. By using something called lipid nanoparticles, BioNTech was having success with stabilizing the mRNA6, and by the time COVID–19 struck, the company had already been collaborating with Pfizer to develop a flu vaccine.

Inside Pfizer, it was dubbed "Project Light Speed," and its purpose was to make the impossible possible: produce a vaccine by the end of the year. Over the next nine months, Pfizer and BioNTech would succeed at one of the most ambitious vaccine development programs in history, shattering the previous record of four years, set by the development of a mumps vaccine in the 1960s10. The speed and precision were made possible by seamless collaborations, across companies, and across countries, working together to scale up manufacturing and meet the unheard-of goal of producing billions of vaccine doses. It's taken dedication, sacrifice, cooperation, and endless hours spent on video calls.

On August 23, 2021, the FDA announced the first approval of a COVID-19 vaccine, the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine, marketed as Comirnaty, for the prevention of COVID-19 in individuals 12 years of age and older.

Strongly recommend both COVID-19 and flu vaccines:

- Influenza and COVID-19 vaccination for patients ages 6 months and older.
- Higher dose or adjuvanted influenza vaccines preferred for adults ages 65 and older.
- Updated (bivalent) COVID-19 boosters for those age 5 and older if it has been 2 months since their last booster or primary series dose.



Give COVID-19 and flu vaccines at the same visit:

- · Coadministration of these vaccines is recommended by the CDC.
- COVID-19 vaccines administered with flu vaccine showed similar immunogenicity and similar or slightly higher reactogenicity compared to separate administration; no safety concerns were identified.
